Nominations are being accepted by the Lewis County Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors for the Lewis County Business Person of the Year Award for 2017. If you would like to nominate someone, please submit your choice of a candidate no later than Friday, September 29, 4 p.m., to the Chamber office at 7576 S. State St., Lowville, NY 13367.

Below are the nominating procedures and criteria. The "official nominating form" is at the bottom of this page, which should be used to submit the name of your candidate.

Nominating Procedures

1. All nominations are to be submitted on the official entry form. The forms may be augmented with other documentation attached to this form.
2. Nominations must be received in the Chamber office no later than Friday, September 29, by 4 p.m.
3. Entries will be judged by the Lewis County Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.
4. The award will be formally presented at the Lewis County Chamber of Commerce Annual Business Person of the Year Award Dinner on Thursday, November 16th.

Nominating Criteria

1. Emphasis will be placed on business and community involvement. Significant accomplishments from past years may be included as additional supporting evidence.
2. The award is made on the basis of outstanding civic contributions to the Lewis County community. Entries will be judged on five key areas:
 - a. Achievement
 - b. Outstanding Citizenship
 - c. Leadership
 - d. Dedication
 - e. Motivation
3. Nominee must be a Chamber Member in good standing.
4. There are no posthumous awards.
5. The Lewis County Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors has the right to waive the award in any year where it is felt that a suitable nominee has not been presented. The judgment of the Board of Directors is final.
